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**CoreCivic to Lose Federal Contract at Tennessee Detention Facility**

CoreCivic Inc., a private-prison operator, said Friday that it expects to lose a contract with the U.S. Marshals Service for its 600-bed West Tennessee Detention Facility in Mason, Tenn. The company's contract with the Marshals Service for the facility is set to expire at the end of September. The Marshals Service recently notified CoreCivic that all inmates will be transferred out of the facility by the end of the month, the company said. For the six months through June, the facility generated revenue of \$10.2 million, CoreCivic said. Its revenue in 2020 was \$18.4 million. CoreCivic is marketing the site for use to other government agencies, the company said.
